Big Rock Exploration AB's associated company Holmasjön Prospektering AB has been recommended to drill another 1300 meters on the Kallmora field.

Holmasjön Prospektering "The company" has been recommended to drill 800 meters spread over five holes on the eastern anomaly within the Kallmora exploration permit. In addition to this, the company has previously been recommended to drill 500 meters distributed over five holes on the western anomaly.

In May 2021, the company drilled a hole each on the two anomalies. The hole on the western anomaly contained levels up to 13.75% lead and 6.61% zinc as well as copper, iron and elevated levels of several rare earth metals. The hole on the eastern anomaly contained concentrations of 0.73% copper and 37% iron as well as several rare earth metals at a depth of only a few meters.

The purpose of future drilling programs is to investigate the extent of the minerals found in May. If minerals are found in these boreholes, they will also form the basis for a future application for a processing concession.

In addition to the drilling, Holmasjön Prospektering AB has been recommended additional exploration initiatives that increase the potential for the Kallmora field.
