Big Rock Exploration AB has submitted a work plan for magnetic and electrical VLF surveys on the Rostberget exploration permit.

The exploration permit includes a number of smaller mines from the 1890s, where SGU reports high levels of silver, gold, copper, iron, lead and zinc.

Rostberget is an exploration permit in Ludvika municipality, Dalarna county. At the mines on Rostberget, SGU has detected 205 ppm silver, 12.6 ppm gold, 0.43% copper, 28.3% iron, 4.06% lead and 7.04% zinc. From an economic point of view, these mineral contents are very interesting individually. During the second quarter, Big Rock Exploration AB intends to perform magnetic and electrical VLF surveys to investigate the extent of this mineralization.
