Big Rock Exploration AB's associated company Holmasjön Prospektering AB has completed the first borehole

Holmasjön Prospektering AB's first borehole in this drilling campaign has now been drilled. The hole was drilled to 76.5 meters and several zones with minerals were found.

The drilling of the first hole in this drilling campaign was completed at 76.5 meters last night (2022-06-14). A zone with iron was found between 3.6 to 10 meters. It is too early to comment on concentrations as the cores must first be analysed.

Between 10 and 25 meters, several quartz veins were found in volcanic rocks. The company intends to analyse these for gold. This is because gold may occur in quartz veins.

From 25 meters to 71 meters there were two forms of iron, magnetite and hematite. Iron levels can only be presented after analysis. In this interval, the Company also intends to analyse the cores for rare earth metals REE.

The drilling rig has now been moved to the second drill site out of five. An update will come as soon as this hole is completed
